The **PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary SAT I National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test)** is given **nationally ONLY ONE time a year**. Sophomores SHOULD take the PSAT to experience the testing environment and practice taking a standardized test. Juniors should take the PSAT for the below reasons, as well as a “route-of-entry to NMSC (National Merit Scholarship Corporation) scholarship competitions.” Students are encouraged to take the PSAT **BOTH** their sophomore and junior years.

By taking the PSAT/NMSQT, JUNIORS can:

- ★ Enter the National Merit Scholarship competition and other scholarship competitions
- ★ Practice for SAT Reasoning Test (College Entrance Exam)
- ★ Request colleges to send information about programs, activities, and financial aid

By taking the PSAT/NMSQT, SOPHOMORES can:

- ★ Practice for PSAT/SAT Reasoning Test
- ★ Request colleges to send information about programs activities, and financial aid
- ★ Be selected by the district for the Scholars Program
- ★ PSAT scores can be used for Dual Credit placement

The **Scholars Program** is a district sponsored PSAT Preparation Program for **sophomores**. Students are selected based on the Selection Index score they receive when they take the PSAT as a sophomore.
